
CONVENTIONAL SYMBOLS

- ¹ For clarity, on some plans the lower level is shown in gray or using denser dashes.
- ² On some profiles, ledges are marked with this kind of line. On plans it always means a ceiling feature.
- ³ Symbols used when features are too small to use perpendicular ticks.
- ⁴ Both symbols used, meaning is the same.
- Note: the same symbol is used for an entrance arrow and a gradient arrow.
- ⁶ Note: similar to the moonmilk symbol.
